From Carlsbad/Oceanside/Encinitas: Take Interstate 5 North. Take Highway 78 East. Take Interstate 15 South. Exit Rancho Bernardo Road East. Continue 3 miles and turn left onto Old Coach Road. Proceed 1.3 miles to Maderas Golf Club. (Driving Time: Approx. 30 minutes)

From El Cajon: Take Highway 67 North. Turn left onto Poway Road. Turn right onto Espola Road. Proceed 3 miles and turn right onto Old Coach Road. Proceed 1.3 miles to Maderas Golf Club. (Driving Time: Approx. 30 minutes)

From Los Angeles/Orange County: Take Interstate 5 South. Take Highway 78 East. Take Interstate 15 South. Exit Rancho Bernardo Road East. Continue 3 miles and turn left onto Old Coach Road. Proceed 1.3 miles to Maderas Golf Club. (Driving Time: Approx. 1-2 hours)

From Riverside/San Bernardino Counties: Take Interstate 15 South. Exit Rancho Bernardo Road East. Continue 3 miles and turn left onto Old Coach Road. Proceed 1.3 miles to Maderas Golf Club. (Driving Time: Approx. 1-2 hours)
