The revolution in AEC production has taken us from Design-Build, to Design-Build, to Design-Build Done Right and Progressive Design-Build. One might well ask, "Does it get any better than this?" For all of us who embrace the "pursuit of perfection" and "continuous process improvement" as a life quest, the answer is always, "yes!" For the last 20 years, DBIA and LCI have been attacking the same problem, AEC industry productivity improvement, on parallel tracks. This presentation reviews Lean Principles and they relate to Design-Build Done Right, and suggests lean tools and approaches, both current and under development, that will help any Design-Build project reap the potential benefits of Lean Construction.
