ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must be enrolled, at time of application and continuing education during the 2026 – 2027 academic year, in a trade school, community college or university in the Western Pacific Region of the U.S. (Arizona, California, Hawaii, or Nevada). DBIA encourages applications from all qualified students. Freshmen through Seniors, and Graduate students, are welcome to apply, as long as you will be continuing your education during the 2026-2027 academic year. High School students are not eligible to participate.

- Students in good standing, making reasonable progress towards a degree in: Construction Management, Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Architectural Engineering, Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Interior Design, or another major pertinent to Design and Construction. 2.7 minimum cumulative G.P.A.
