#### PRESENTATION OVERVIEW

As such, it is foreseeable that some of the projects planned (and maybe some not in the planning stages) in the 5 year plus time frame might be accelerated due to the need for water, and/or as well as any new political champions pushing the effort. With the approval of Prop 1, there is now a competition for the approved funds amongst various agencies and private parties. Part of the reviewing and selection of projects to receive the Prop 1 funding is how close they are to being shovel ready. In this light, we will hear the Agencies' plans to develop local supplies through a number of methods, and how they will utilize innovative delivery methods like Design-Build to accelerate projects.
