The project was considered a success by all parties and subsequently won numerous awards including AZ Big Media RED Awards Healthcare Project of the Year, Healthcare Design Award of Merit, AIA/AA Healthcare Design Award and most recently the DBIA WPR Project of the Year and Design Excellence awards.
