His other notable projects are the \$906M California Health Care Facility (CHCF) Stockton; a unique 1.2M sf prison healthcare facility which was completed in record time and the \$392M Capitol Area East End Complex in Sacramento.

Mike has participated in over \$2.5B worth of Design-Build projects and has been involved with DBIA for several years. He is currently on the Western Pacific Region Board Executive Committee as the Owner's Council Director.
