- 2. Are there at least four concrete and substantive strategies, "lessons learned" or practical tools that attendees can take away from your session and apply to their next capital project?
- 3. Are you (and co-presenters where relevant) dynamic presenters and comfortable engaging in audience Q&A?
- 4. If proposing a case study, is the **owner confirmed to participate** in the presentation, and is there a **clear lesson/message?**

- 1. Presentation Title Title should capture the essence of the topic to be discussed and should not exceed 10 to 12 words.
- 2. Presentation Summary Please provide an overview of the session intent and why the topic is relevant to successful integrated delivery. The summary statement should not exceed 75 words and may be used for marketing purposes should your presentation be selected.
- Program Abstract This 200 to 500-word description should explain how the program relates to design-build project delivery and how attendees will benefit from this session.
- 4. Four Major Presentation Points Points should be succinct and answer the question "what will attendees learn and/or take away from this session?"
